



May Tip - Suspicious User's

Based on a tip provided by **Rich Loeber** to search400.com

Rich Loeber gives the example of a department head coming to him regarding an employee's misuse of the phone system. Rich states that most phone systems, upon entering the employee's phone number, can return a detailed listing of phone calls made/received.

After a bit of research, Rich found that OS/400 has some pretty powerful user auditing tools. Here is how to create an audit log for an individual user using the OS/400 audit journaling command.

Please note that the IBM reference for the below listed commands are attached.

1. **Start Security Audit Journaling** - use the command **CHGSECAUD QAUDCTL(*OBJAUD *NOQTEMP *AUDLVL) QAUDLVL(*ALL)**
2. **Start Auditing Suspicious User(s)** - enter the command **CHGUSRAUD USRPRF(*USERNAME*) OBJAUD(*ALL) AUDLVL(*CREATE *DELETE)**
3. **Specify user audit tracking for the group of objects you want tracked** - Do this with the **CHGOBJAUD** command for regular os/400 objects or the **CHGDLOAUD** for IFS objects.
4. **View the activity** - via the command **DSPJRN JRN(QAUDJRN)**
